

## **CROCHET PENNANT PATTERN**

I used a 4 ply wool and a size 4.00 hook

Stitches used (UK Terms) ch chain, dc double crochet, tr treble crochet

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Stitched from the point upwards but would work just as well reversed and decreasing instead of increasing.

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**To Start: Chain 3**

**Foundation Row: work 1 dc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch, 1 dc in remaining stitch (3sts) turn**

**Row 1 : 1 ch (counts as 1<sup>st</sup> st), 2dc in 2<sup>nd</sup> st, 1dc (4st)**

**Row 2 : 1 ch, 1 dc in 2<sup>nd</sup> st, 1 dc in each rem st (4st)**

**Row 3: 1 ch, 1dc in 2<sup>nd</sup> st, 1 dc in each st until 2<sup>nd</sup> to last st 2dc in same st, 1dc in last st (5st)**

**Row 4: As row 3 (6st)**

**\*\* Row 5: 1 ch, 1dc in 2<sup>nd</sup> st, 1dc in each rem st (6st)**

**Row 6: As row 5 (6st)**

**Row 7: 1ch, 1dc in 2<sup>nd</sup> st then 1dc in each rem st until 2<sup>nd</sup> to last st 2dc in same st, 1dc in last st (7st)**

**Row 8: As Row 7 (8st)\*\***

**Repeat \*\* to \*\* increasing until you reach size of pennant pattern**

**I finished up with 46 stitches and 65 rows but will depend on your tension**

**I worked 7 rows of treble crochet for the fold over tube section.**

**If you use treble crochet throughout instead of double, ch 2 to turn and it makes up a slightly skinnier pennant!**

**Hope this makes sense to everyone – please let me know if there are any glitches or problem with the pattern and I'll do my best to help**
